
Reading





This half term the children will get to read and listen to lots of different stories. Below are some of the books they will be reading. Please encourage your child to tell you about the stories or read other books by the same author.








Year 3

Last half term, Year 1 enjoyed their learning in Science where they had to name and classify various animals, including birds and reptiles. During one Science lesson, Mr Oakley brought in a seabream fish and they looked at all the key parts (eyes, fins, scales and tail) and learnt how it lives and moves under water. The children were genuinely 'wowed' by the lesson and produced some amazing diagrams of the fish.




The children have also enjoyed creating landscape scenes in the style of J.M.W. Turner. They used his pointillism techniques and merged colours to make a landscape picture.

This half term, the children will continue learning about naming and classifying animals, design and build a product for home in DT, learn about the history of the school in History and use digital imagery in Computing.
