

Phonics at Home



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Below are some ideas to help your child with phonics at home.			
	Sing songs and rhymes	Hunt for words containing same sound/phoneme around the room; on the way to school.	Hunt for sounds/phonemes in words e.g. /i/ b i n i n k
	Rhyming words. Think of a word that rhymes withdog frog log	Say the sounds in a word - "b -e-d" Can your child guess what it is?	Match sounds to pictures or objects 'c' - cat 'r' - robot
	Play 'I spy' e.g. "something beginning with b" ball? bag? bat?	Play snap and pairs games with words containing the same sound 'e' elephant eggs	Have a go at writing letters to go with phonemes and simple words box
	Play Kim's game with letters, words or objects starting with the same sound. Take one away. Which one is missing?	Make words - using plastic letters; cut out letters from a newspaper	Make a bingo game using phonemes/sounds or words being covered.
	Cut words up into their	Play letter hunts	Hunt for sounds/phonemes

phonemes/sounds. Place in an envelope. Can your child rearrange them?

e.g. h-a-t Can they tell you a sentence with the word in?



Ask your child to collect letters hidden around the house or garden. What sound does it make?

Phonics in Reception



The children will learn up to 4 new phonemes/letter sounds a week. They will also be taught tricky words at each phase that <u>cannot</u> be sounded out/decoded.

Phase 2 phonemes/letter sounds:

satp inmd gock ckeur hbffflllss

Phase 2 tricky words - the; to; no; go; I; into

Phase 3 phonemes/letter sounds:

By the end of Phase 3 the children will know one way of writing down each of the 44 phonemes/letter sounds.

Phase 3 tricky words - you; they; all; are; my; her; he; she; we; me; be; was
