Important buttons to learn when typing on a computer.



## Key Vocabulary

Backspace	A key that moves the cursor backwards.
Delete (text)	The button on the keyboard that deletes (removes) text.
Image	A picture or diagram.
Import	To place another file into a document, such as an image.
Keyboard	An input device, made up of buttons or keys, that creates letters, numbers and symbols on the computer screen.
Keyboard character	Any letter, symbol, space, number or punctuation that can be input using the keyboard.
Paste	Inset copied or cut text into a document.
Touch type	Using a keyboard with all of your fingers, without needing to look at the letters on the keys.
Undo	To take a step back and delete the last thing that you did.
Word processing	A program used for creating text documents on a computer.
