Different rhythms are arranged into a structure in a finished piece of music. Musical texture can be recorded by using a different line for each different instrument. The texture of a piece of music describes its different layers.

Experimental music can be recorded using a graphic score.

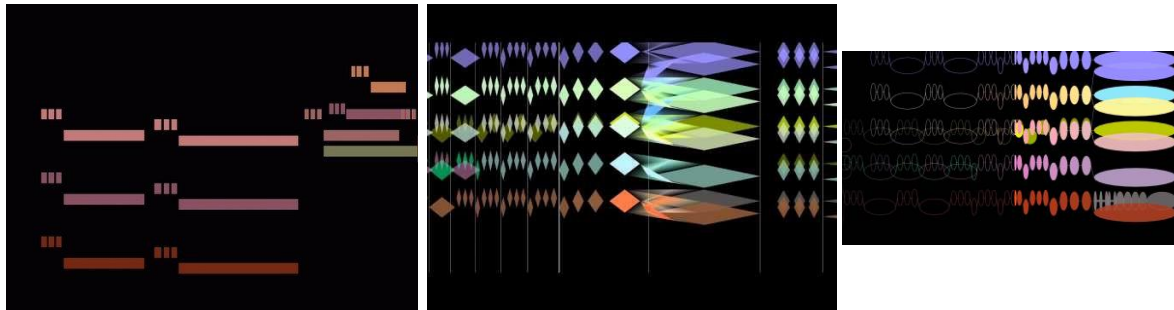

Key Vocabulary

symphony	A musical composition for a full orchestra.
Graphic score	A pictorial record of a piece of music.
rhythm	a strong, regular repeated pattern of sound.
texture	Refers to the layers of sound in a piece of music.
compose	To create a work of musical art.
Structure	The arrangement of different sections within the whole piece.
