Each season the leaves on most trees change.

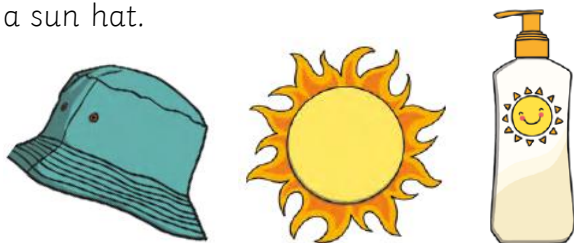
## Key Vocabulary

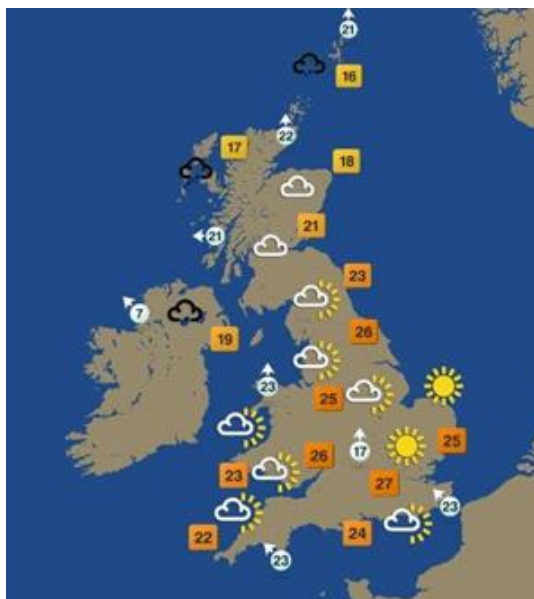
The weather **affects** what we do and what we wear. If it is rainy, we wear **waterproof** clothes when we go outside.
