Homework

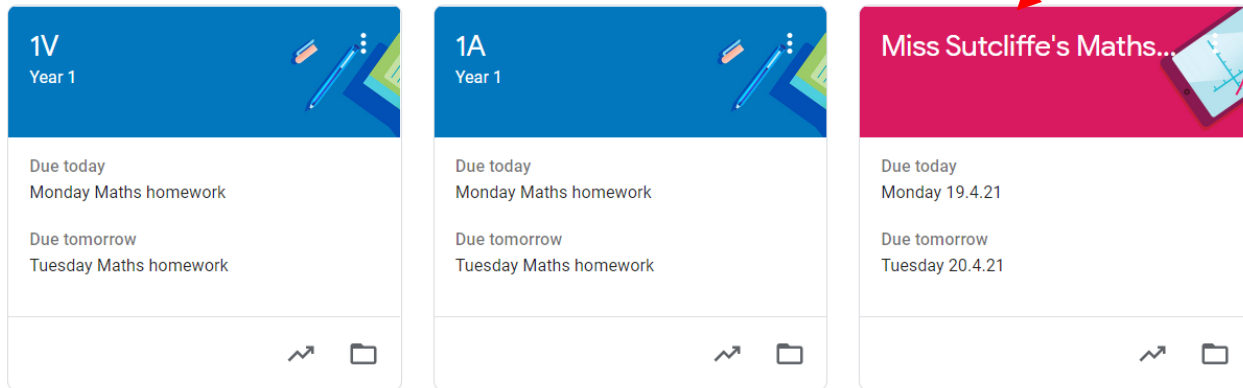

Please read with your child every night and don't forget to sign your child's book. Your child will continue to have spellings to learn each week.

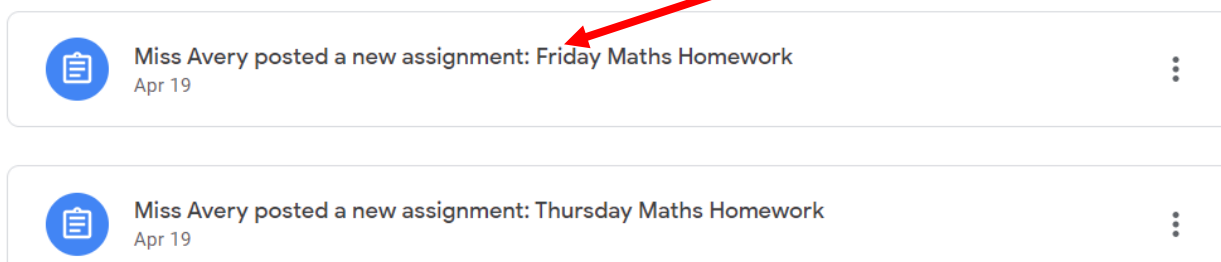


Below are some useful tips to help with Google Classroom.

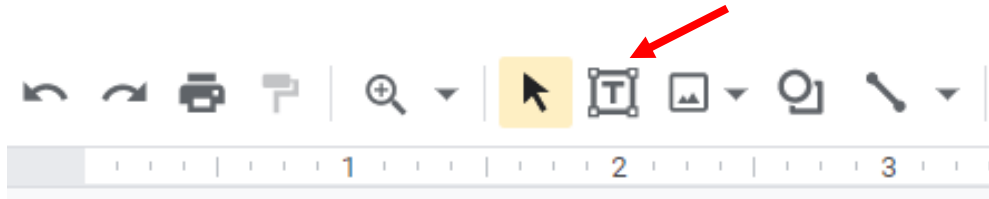
Choose the class they are in. If they are with Miss Sutcliffe for Maths they need to click on her group.



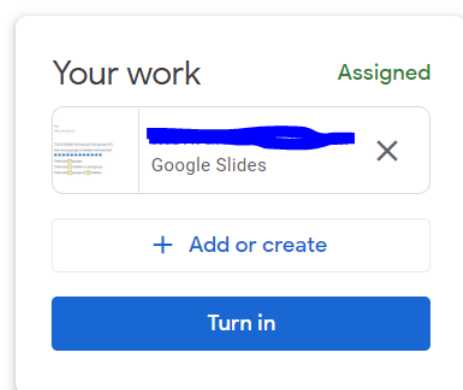
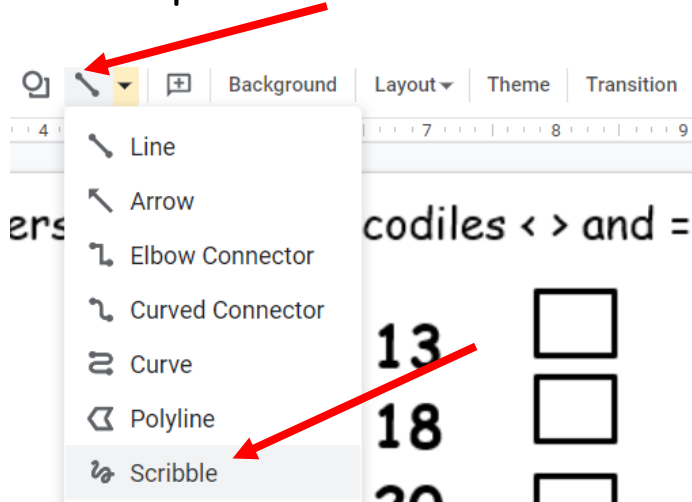
Click on the work to complete for each day.
