
Reception Class

Spring Term January-February 2020



This half-term our topic is 'Space'. We will be covering the following:

Communication, Language & Literacy

- Further development of speaking and listening skills; answering and asking questions; following and giving instructions.
- Set 1/2 RWI letter sounds; oral blending and segmenting; using phonics to write simple words and captions.
- Writing sentences; writing a list for a picnic on the moon; describing the rockets we have designed and creating our own aliens. We will also be describing our day, using the language of time.
- Reading red words and familiar words; using phonics to read simple words and captions in our phonics sessions and during Department Time.
- Acting out stories with our friends.
- Looking at and beginning to use non-fiction books.

Mathematics

- Number songs and rhymes to support simple addition and subtraction.
- Recognising, ordering and writing numbers from 0-10 and 11-20; ordinal numbers.
- My day exploring the passing of time and using simple clocks.
- Combining 2 sets to find out how many are altogether; exploring different ways of making 10; number bonds to 10.
- Ordinal numbers through the story of the Chinese New Year.
- 3D shapes matching, describing and naming

Understanding of the World

- Day and Night- similarities and differences; nocturnal animals.
- Space travel to the moon and outer space; exploring different planets.
- Festivals Chinese New Year the Year of the Rat.
- How and why people celebrate; traditions special food and clothes.
- I.C.T. Introduction to the I.C.T. suite. Using simple programmes; developing mouse control; use of bee-bots and remote-controlled toys.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

- Differences between our likes and dislikes and those of others, including fears of the dark etc.
- Seasonal changes.
- Looking after each other and our school environment and the world we live in.
- Sharing and helping others.

Expressive Arts & Design

- Songs and rhymes to go with our topic.
- Painting and drawing; exploring contrasting colours, including light and dark.
- Investigating ways of joining materials together.
- Designing and making space rockets using junk and 3D shapes.
- Exploring texture and collage using different materials to create aliens.
- Acting out familiar stories in the role play areas; small world; puppets.
- Role play The Post Office; The Space Station; Chinese Take Away cafe.

Physical Development

- Use of simple tools pencils, scissors, rolling pins and cutters.
- Outdoor play using bikes & trikes; use of climbing apparatus; small bats and balls; bean bags; hoops.
- Developing independence with dressing and self-help skills.
