

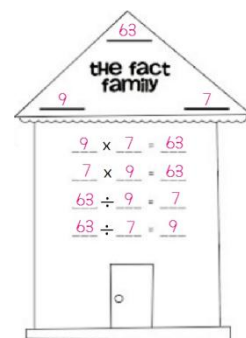
## Year Three

Year Three are having a fantastic Summer term! We have had a Roald Dahl Day, a singing workshop and a visit to a Synagogue and Gurdwara. Next week as part of our Roald Dahl topic we will be visiting the Roald Dahl Story Centre and Museum in Great Missenden.



In English this half term we will focus on non-fiction writing including biographies and non-chronological reports. Continue to support your child in spelling all Key Stage 1 words and most Year 3 and 4 common exception words.

In Maths we continue to focus on telling the time to the nearest minute. Please encourage your child to tell the time at various points during the day using a digital and analogue clock. We will be consolidating multiplication and corresponding division facts e.g.  $4 \times 3 = 12$  and  $12 \div 3 = 4$  for the 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables.



We will carry on doing PE outside each week and the children will take part in some internal tournaments. Please ensure your child's PE kit is in a named PE bag (not a plastic bag) and returned the next day after any sports clubs after school.



Please continue to support your child with their daily Reading, Maths and Spelling challenges, we will be sending home some additional handwriting practise for the remainder of the summer term.
