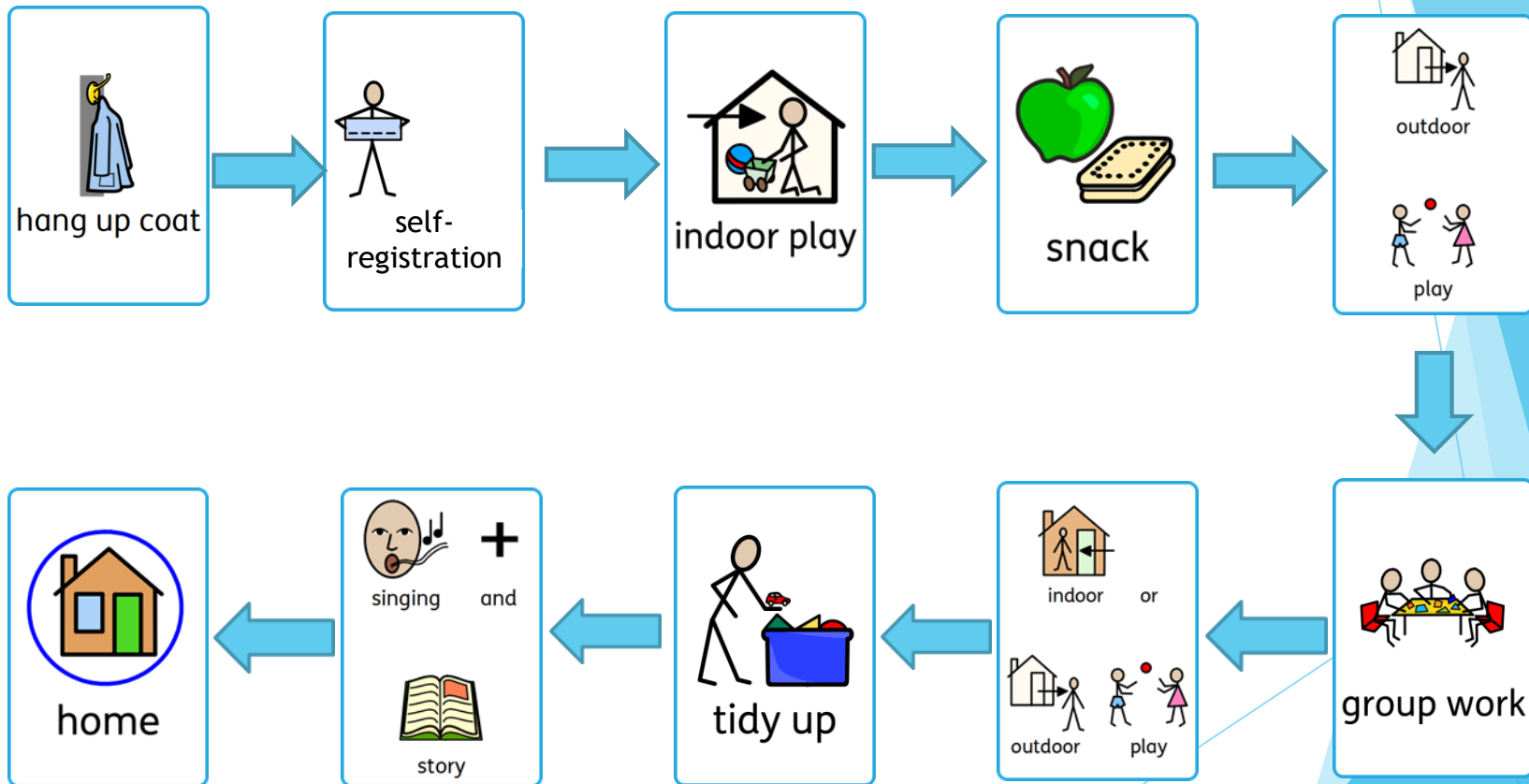

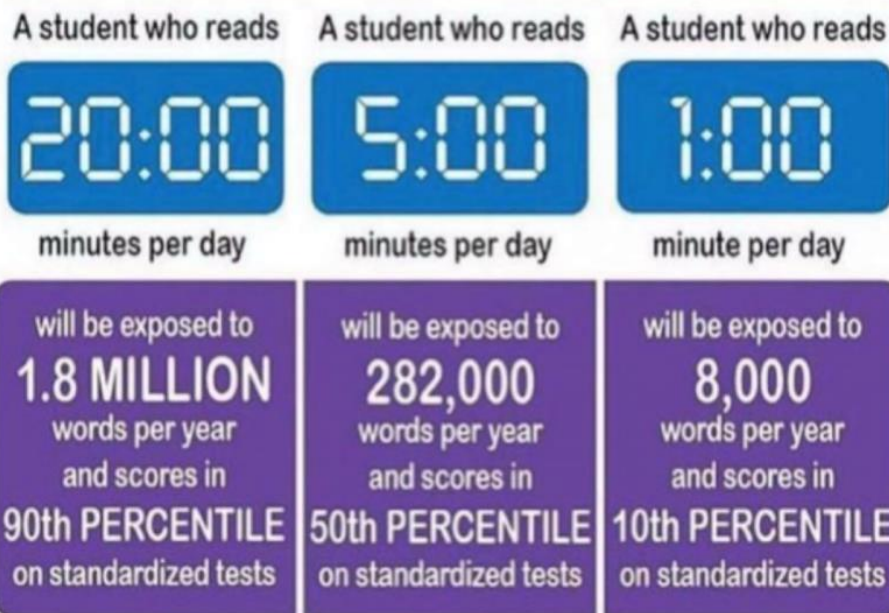


# Reading!

Competent readers achieve better at GCSE & A-Level

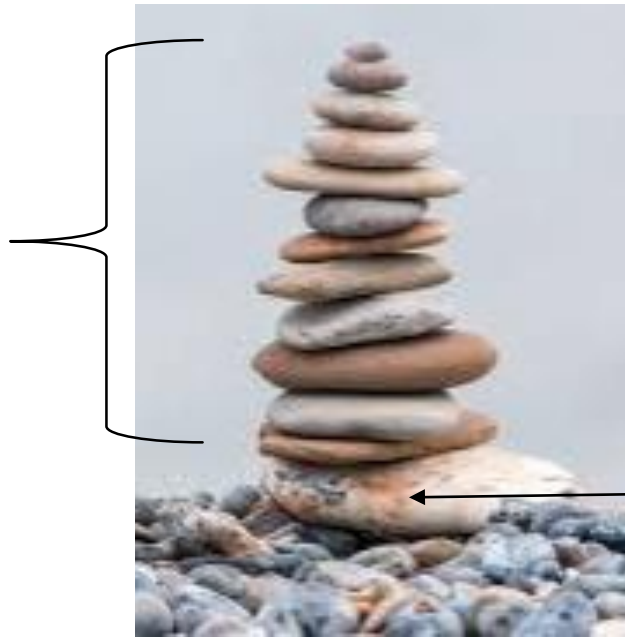
