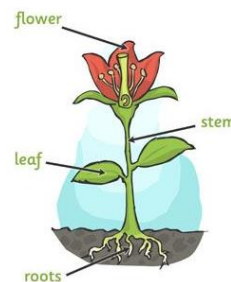
grow 	gets bigger over time	hero 	a character who is good and well liked

5. Plants need water and **sunlight** to **grow**.

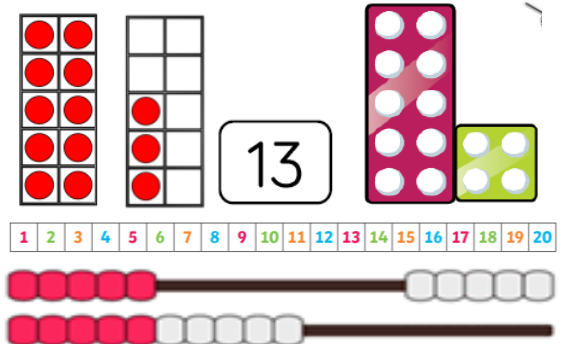
