



Summer Term April - May 2019



## Minibeasts







This half-term our topic is Minibeasts. We are going to be looking after caterpillars and watching them turn into butterflies. Zoo Lab will be visiting us with lots of different bugs. We will be covering the following:

#### Communication, Language & Literacy:

- Speaking and listening skills; listening to and joining in with familiar stories and rhymes; retelling and sequencing stories.
- Set 2 sounds in phonics; learning to read and write 'red' and 'green' words as well as simple words and sentences with increasing independence and confidence.
- Writing labels for minibeasts; describing minibeasts; writing a list; writing a recount; making up our own stories.
- Using non-fiction books to find out about minibeasts and lifecycles.

#### Mathematics:

- Number rhymes and songs to explore addition and subtraction.
- Recognising, ordering and writing numbers from 0-20 and beyond.
- Simple problem-solving including doubling and halving.
- Exploring the order of numbers what comes before/after and in-between.
- Money addition to 10p and beyond.
- Counting in twos and tens; exploring number patterns on a 100-square.
- Using a number line, counting forwards and backwards to add and take away.
- -Time days of the week.
- Patterns copying and making repeated patterns.
- Exploring symmetry.

#### Understanding of the World:

- Going on a minibeast hunt; talking about the environment.
- Exploring different minibeasts and insects habitats; food; movement; body parts and patterns.
- Talking about similarities and differences.
- Lifecycle of a butterfly and frog; growth and change over time.
- Care of living things.
- Seasonal changes.
- I.C.T. Developing mouse control; using simple tools on different programmes; using programmable toys and simple cameras.

#### Personal, Social & Emotional Development:

- Developing independent learning skills; making choices.
- Looking after minibeasts in our environment; looking after the world we live in.
- Sharing and working together.
- Celebrating similarities and differences.

#### Expressive Arts & Design:

- Learning new minibeast songs and rhymes.
- Drawing and painting minibeasts; observational drawing.
- Exploring printing using different objects; repeated patterns and colour mixing.
- 3D model making playdoh; salt dough minibeasts; exploring how to join materials together.
- Exploring different construction materials.
- Role play Flower Shop; Bug hut; tent; acting out familiar stories and rhymes.

#### Physical Development:

- Exploring different ways of moving like minibeasts.
- Outdoor play using bikes & trikes; use of climbing apparatus; small bats and balls; bean bags; hoops.
- Use of simple tools scissors; rolling pins and cutters; glue and sellotape; split pins.
