Paramedics travel in ambulances now but hundreds of year ago ambulances were horses and carts.

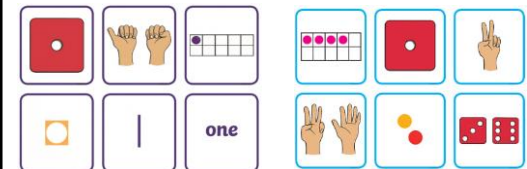
