


### Key concepts

### Note Rhythms

Note Rhythms describe the changes between longer and shorter notes.

### Key Vocabulary

lyrics	Words of a song
solo	A performance by a single person
ensemble	A group of performers
melody	tune
vocally	With voice and audible sound.
notation	Recording of musical notes.
stave	A set of five horizontal lines and four spaces
crotchet	A note worth one beat.
minim	A long note, worth 2 beats.
quaver	A short note, worth half a beat.
pulse	The heartbeat of music.
Aural memory	Remembering what has been heard.
