You add 's' to a noun to make
it plural
car $\longrightarrow$ cars
$\mathrm{dog} \rightarrow$ dogs


Rule 2
When a word ends in $s, x, z, c h$ or sh you add 'es' fox $\rightarrow$ foxes bush $\rightarrow$ bushes
