<b>capital letter</b>	Big letter used to start sentences and for names. A B C D E F G H I J K L M N O P Q R S T U V W X Y Z
<b>word</b>	Groups of letters put together to give meaning Separated by finger spaces
<b>singular</b>	One object cat, dog, pen, box
<b>plural</b>	More than one object Cats, dogs, pens, boxes
<b>sentence</b>	A group of words that make sense.

### Suffix rules

#### Rule 1

You add 's' to a noun to make it plural

car → cars

dog → dogs

#### Rule 2

When a word ends in s, x, z, ch or sh you add 'es'

fox → foxes

bush → bushes



Other suffixes are added to the end of words so they make sense in a sentence.

Use **and** to join words and ideas.

We went to the park **and** we played on the swings.  
The dog is black **and** white.

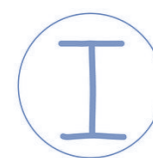
### Remember to...
