Daily reading practice throughout the holiday makes a huge difference to your child's education.

A big thank you to Mr Qasim and his team of staff/volunteers, both from within our school and those from the wider community, whose hard work and generosity made our Sunday Funday such a great success. It was a great day, drawing together approximately 2000 people from the school and local community.
