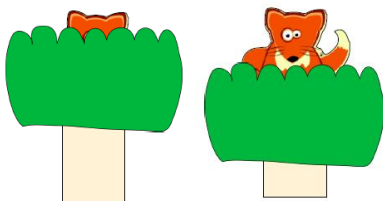


## Technical knowledge

Lots of storybooks have moving parts to make the pages more exciting. Different techniques can be used to make moving pictures, including using sliders and wheels.

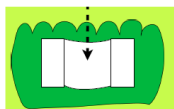
### Using sliders to make a picture appear and disappear



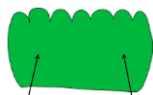
1. Stick a picture of what will disappear at the top of a small strip of paper.



2. Make and stick a small tab on the back of what your picture will hide behind. Make sure the handle can go in and out.



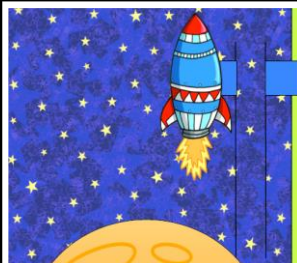
3. Stick both edges of the picture down



4. Use the handle to move your picture up and down through the tab.



## Moving Pictures



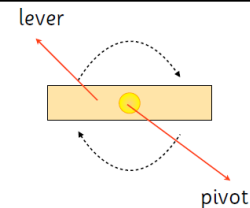
## Key Vocabulary

lever

A bar or strip that rests on a pivot and can move.

pivot

A point or pin on which something can move or rotate.



mechanism

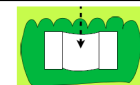
A set of parts that work together to move.

join

To link or connect two or more things.

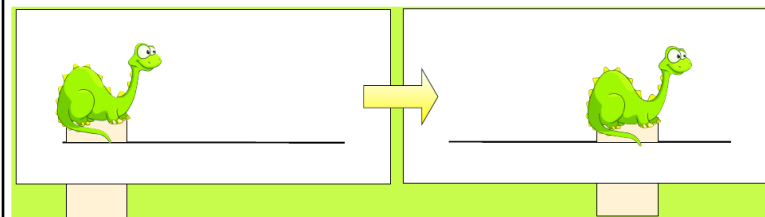
tab

A small flap or strip used to hold or join two things.



slider

A lever that is moved horizontally or vertically to move something



## Keeping safe

Take care when using paper fasteners, they can be sharp. Use a pencil to make a small hole in paper and card, before putting the split pin in.
