Year 1

As part of the wider curriculum the children will be learning about plants in Science, investigating weather patterns in Geography and creating seaside snacks in DT.

Year 2



Last half term the children enjoyed their topic 'How does your garden grow?' They learned about plants during their science lessons and enjoyed planting seeds. As part of the Learning For Life the children were challenged to work together to create a garden area on the KS1 playground. The children chose the flowers and plants they wanted, planted them and will continue to look after the garden.

As part of the wider curriculum the children will be learning about habitats in Science. They will compare the habitats of Africa and Antarctica.
