











## Magnificent Minibeasts

### Vocabulary

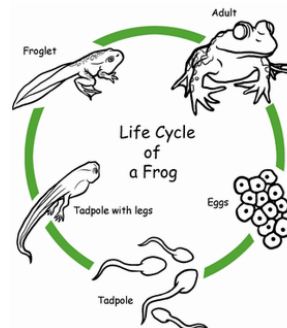
<b>Minibeast</b> 	a small creature like an insect or spider	<b>cocoon</b> 	a covering that protects an animal or insect

5. A spider is not a insect because it does not have 6 legs.

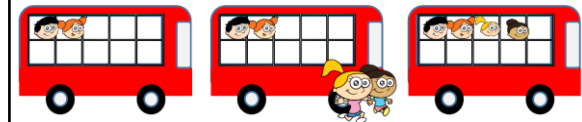

#### Life cycle of a frog

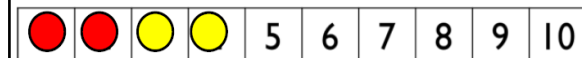


### This half term in Maths we are...
