Composer information

Gustav Theodore Holst was an English composer responsible for 'The Planet Suite' (including Jupiter, Mars, Venus and Neptune).

He was born in September 1874 in Cheltenham, Gloucestershire, and died in May 1934.



The Planets were composed between 1914 and 1916.

Holst composed many more bodies of music, across many genres, but none were as well known as The Planets.
